Requirements for a minor in African Studies – 0305A

General Requirements

At least 6 credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

Specific Requirements

Students must successfully complete at least 15 hours of coursework in African Studies, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level.

1. Language (3 hours) – Third semester foreign language

2. Social Sciences (6 hours) - Two courses selected from the following:

 - COMM 2003 Communication in Nonwestern Culture

 - ECON 4823 Introduction to Comparative Economic Systems
 - ECON 4853 World Economic Development
 - GEOG 2603 World Regional Geography
 - GEOG 3223 The British Empire and Its Successor States
 - IAS 2603 Governments Around the World
 - IAS 3003 Topics in International and Area Studies (content based on Africa)
 - P SC 2603 Governments Around the World
 - P SC 3623 Politics of Transitional Areas
 - SOC 3753 Sociology of Africa

3. Arts and Humanities (6 hours) – Two courses selected from the following:
 - FVS 3833 Masterpieces of World Cinema (content based on Africa)
 - FVS 3843 Topics in National Cinemas (content based on Africa)
 - HIST 2713 Survey of African Civilization
 - HIST 3723 Africa Since 1945
 - HIST 3743 Southern Africa Since 1800
 - HIST 3783 Africa Since 1800
 - MLLL 3000 Literature in Translation (content based on Africa)

All courses listed above are approved for African Studies, though not all courses have been approved for General Education credit. Courses not listed above may be substituted with the approval of the African Studies coordinator.

No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the African Studies coordinator.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
