Requirements for a minor in European Studies – 0315C

General Requirements

At least 6 credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

Specific Requirements

Students must successfully complete at least 15 hours of courses acceptable for major credit in European Studies, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level. The following specific requirements must be met:

1. Language (3 hours) – Third semester foreign language
 - FR 2113
 - GERM 2113
 - ITAL 2113
 - PORT 2113
 - SPAN 2113

2. Social Sciences (6 hours) - Two courses selected from the following:
 - COMM 3513, 4513
 - ECON 4823, 4853
 - GEOG 2603, 3513
 - IAS 2603, 3003 (content based on Europe), 3213
 - P SC 3603, 3613, 3673, 3713, 4643

3. Arts and Humanities (6 hours) – Two courses selected from the following:
 - A HI 4303, 4333, 4353, 4373, 4403, 4503, 4553, 4633, 4653, 4913 (content based on Europe)
 - FVS 3833, 3843 (content based on Europe)
 - HIST 3073, 3120, 3123, 3143, 3153, 3163, 3173, 3183, 3193, 3203, 3213, 3223, 3233, 3243, 3253, 3263, 3273, 3283, 3290, 3323, 3333, 3343, 3353, 3363, 3373, 3503, 3603, 3763, 3833, 3933, 3943
 - MLLL 3000 (content based on Europe), 3823, 3843, 3853, 3943, 4663
 - MUSC 2323, 3333

All courses listed above are approved for European Studies, though not all courses have been approved for General Education credit. Courses not listed above may be substituted with the approval of European Studies coordinator.

No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the European Studies coordinator.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
