Requirements for a minor in Film and Video Studies - 0606A

General Requirements

At least 6 credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

Specific Requirements

Students must successfully complete at least 18 hours of courses acceptable for major credit in Film and Video Studies, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level. The following specific requirements must be met:

1. FVS 1013
2. FVS 2013 **or** FVS 2023
3. 12 additional hours from courses approved for FVS major credit

No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Film and Video Studies program.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
