## Requirements for a minor in Judaic Studies – 1111B

### General Requirements

At least 6 credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

### Specific Requirements

Students must successfully complete 18-20 hours from courses designated for the Judaic Studies minor, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level. Students must complete two semesters of Hebrew; those who can satisfactorily demonstrate proficiency in Hebrew may substitute two additional Judaic Studies electives for the language courses. The following specific requirements must be met:

3. HEBR 1214
4. 3 of the following courses (9 hours):  
HIST 2013, 3293, 3303, 3313, 3413, 3430 (American Jewish History), 3500, 3840,  
3950 (Ethnography of Israeli Society), 3963, 3983, 5050; ENGL 3633

*No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Judaic Studies program.*

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
