Requirements for a minor in Latin - 1199C

General Requirements

At least 6 credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

Specific Requirements

Students must successfully complete at least 15 hours of coursework in Latin at the 2000 level or above, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level. Note that introductory courses (LAT 1115, 1215, and 1315) are NOT counted toward this total. Students may choose from the following list of courses:

LAT 2113 (max 6 hours), LAT 2213 (not repeatable), LAT 2313 (not repeatable),
 LAT 3113 (max 6 hours), LAT 3213 (max 6 hours), LAT 3990 (max 6 hours),
 LAT 4133 (max 6 hours), LAT 4213 (max 6 hours), LAT 4313 (not repeatable),
 LAT 4503 (not repeatable), 4990 (max 6 hours); or *3 hours of upper-division Classical Culture or related area

No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Latin program in the Classics Department.

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
