## Requirements for a minor in Latin American Studies – 0315E

### General Requirements

At least 6 credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

### Specific Requirements

Students must successfully complete at least 15 hours of courses acceptable for major credit in Latin American Studies, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level. The following specific requirements must be met:

1. Language (3 hours) – Third semester foreign language
  - PORT 2113
  - SPAN 2113
  
2. Social Sciences (6 hours) – Two courses selected from the following:
  - ANTH 3143, 3333, 3883, 3893, 4633
  - COMM 2003, 3513, 4513
  - ECON 4713, 4823, 4853
  - GEOG 2603, 4253, 4263
  - IAS 1303, 2603, 3003 (content based on Latin America), 3313, 3323
  - P SC 2603, 3653
  
3. Arts and Humanities (6 hours) – Two courses selected from the following:
  - A HI 3803, 4843, 4913
  - FVS 3243, 3833, 3843 (content based on Latin America)
  - HIST 2613, 2623, 3690, 3703, 3713, 3000 (content based on Latin America)
  - MLLL 4113, 4553

All courses listed above are approved for Latin American Studies, though not all courses have been approved for General Education credit. Courses not listed above may be substituted with the approval of the Latin American Studies coordinator.

*No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Latin American Studies coordinator.*

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
