### Requirements for a minor in Native American Studies - 2212A

General Requirements

At least 6 credit hours must be earned in courses acceptable for residence credit by standards set forth by the College of Arts and Sciences, excluding transfer, correspondence, and examination (AP, CLEP, Advanced Standing) credit. Courses for the minor may not be taken Pass/No Pass.

Specific Requirements

Students must successfully complete at least 15 hours of courses acceptable for major credit in NAS, including at least 9 hours at the upper-division level. The following specific requirements must be met:

One course from each of the following four groups:

1. ENGL 2733, ENGL 2743, ENGL 3013, ENGL 4343
2. ANTH 2613, HIST 1543, HIST 3633, HIST 3643
3. NAS 4803, NAS 4913, NAS 4933, ANTH 3453
4. AHI 4803, AHI 4813, AHI 4823, AHI 4833, MUNM 3213, ARTC/NAS 4693

Students will select one additional course from any of the four groups above or from the following:

- ANTH 1613, 3503, 4653, 4663, 4673, 4693, 4813
- AHI 3803
- COMM 2313
- ENGL 3253, 3353, 4343
- GEOG 4563
- NAS 3113, NAS 4913, NAS 4933

*No single course may be used by a student to satisfy a major requirement and a minor requirement. A course may be used, however, to satisfy both a major support requirement and a minor requirement. Requests to substitute a minor requirement must be approved in writing by the Native American Studies program.*

The requirements for a minor must be completed concurrently with the major degree requirements. No minor may be added by completing courses after receiving the bachelor's degree. Minors in the College are available to all undergraduate students at OU. If the minor is officially declared, successfully completed, and noted on the graduation application, the student's transcript will so indicate at the time the bachelor's degree is posted.
